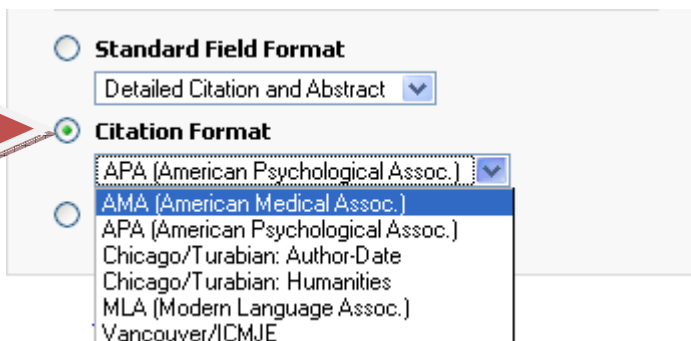

3. From the View screen, click on the printer icon.



4. Click the Citation Format radio button and select APA or MLA.



5. To save time later on, copy and paste the citation onto a document titled Works Cited (MLA) or References (APA). If the citation is in MLA format be sure to fill in the [brackets] with the correct information for [Library Name], [City], and [State Abbreviation].

6. Print

If the article is in HTML format the APA or MLA citation will appear above the article. Click 'print'.

If the article is in .PDF format the citation will appear separately from the article. Click 'print' to print the citation and then click full-text to open the article. Click print again to print the article.
