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Males (any person assigned the sex of male at birth) aged 18–25 are required to register with the Selective Service System (SSS). This requirement covers males residing in the United States who are U.S. citizens or noncitizens, except that a male who is in the U.S. as a lawful nonimmigrant isn't required to register as long as he maintains that status. Students who are required to register with the Selective Service must do so to be eligible for **State** aid funds.

If you did not register for selective service, you must prove that your failure to register was not knowing or willful. The burden of proof is on you to show by a preponderance of evidence that your failure to register was neither knowing nor willful. A preponderance of evidence means a degree of relevant evidence that a reasonable person, considering the record as a whole, would accept as sufficient to support a conclusion that the matter asserted is more likely to be true than not true. Waivers granted are only valid for the agency granting the waiver.

Complete the form and submit it to the address indicated on the form.
2. In addition to any documentation requested above, submit the following to Savannah Technical College Financial Aid Office:
 - a. A copy of the Status Information Letter
 - b. A typed or neatly hand written statement explaining why you did not register with Selective Service between the ages of 18-25, describe your whereabouts during this period of time and how this might have affected you knowing that you were required to register with Selective Service. ***You should also provide any supporting documentation that can support your statement.***
 - c. Two notarized letters of reference from individuals who can attest that your failure to register was not knowing and willful. The references should identify who they are, their relationship to you, how long they have known you, and what they know about your personal history during the ages 18 to 25. The references should give information on your character, community service involvement, jobs held, etc.
